A rare Golden Horde turquoise-inlaid gold necklace of crescent form, decorated in filigree with repeated medallion motifs interspersed by foliate scrollwork, set with three turquoises, suspension loops to each end

Formerly in a UK private collection. Acquired in London in the 1980s.

Led initially by Gengis Khan's son, Juchi, the Golden Horde was established in the lower Volga and Crimea in the thirteenth century. The work of Russian archaeologist M. G. Kramarovsky and his study of the Treasure of Niezatski in Crimea has been cited in relation to Golden Horde jewellery production. His work explored a trove of jewellery including bracelets and phylacteries in the form of pendants. It is these pendants that share the same box construction as this lot (Kramarovsky, M.G., 'Niezatski Treasure: Crimea and Asia Minor in the 14th century', Bizantiya i blizhni Vostok Gosudarstvennogo Ermitazha, XLVII, St. Petersburg, 1994). Another example exists in the Hermitage Museum (Masterpieces of Art in the Hermitage Museum, exhibition held in the Dar al-Athar al-Islamiyyah, Kuwait, 1990, no. 48). This pendant has a similar box construction, and the same combination of filigree and granulation interspersed with set stones.

RARE GEM SET BYZANTINE BRACELET

A rare Byzantine gold bracelet, circa 6th century A.D., composed of articulated oval gem-set links joined by openwork scroll connectors. Each principal link is mounted with a polished cabochon stone in varying colours, including green, red, blue and purple tones, interspersed with smaller pearl-like cabochons arranged in pairs within rounded gold settings.

The bracelet retains a richly decorative late antique character, with bold gold bezels, looped hinge construction and repeating ornamental elements creating a rhythmic jewelled design. The combination of coloured cabochons and gold openwork is characteristic of Byzantine luxury jewellery, reflecting the period's taste for vivid polychromy and portable displays of wealth and status.

Formed in high-karat gold, the earrings feature a deeply modelled rosette at the top, with the pierced floral design of the earrings a clear

Beneath each rosette, an openwork gold bar supports a series of articulated pendant elements. These pendant elements are set with coloured glass inlays and terminate in natural pearls, creating a lively contrast between the warm gold, coloured accents and soft lustre of the pearls. The hinged suspension allows the drops to move freely, animating the design when worn.

The combination of repoussé floral work, openwork construction and suspended ornaments reflects the jewellery traditions of the Eastern Mediterranean in the late Hellenistic and early Imperial Roman periods. Such earrings were conceived not only as adornment but as displays of status, refinement, and technical skill, drawing on established Hellenistic models while answering Roman taste for rich, mobile ornament.
